- To verify current test codes, dates and requirements, go to:

 - To view required tests for Alabama, in the left column, click on EDUCATION PROGRAM CERTIFICATION APPROACHES and then on AL TEACHER ED PROGRAM.
- When registering for the Praxis II, individuals must request that test results be sent to:
 - The University of South Alabama CODE 1880 (Important Note: There is more than one University of South Alabama code. In order for the College of Education to receive your score report, you MUST select Code 1880.)
 - If you test in the state of Alabama, your scores will automatically be sent to the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) (Code 7020).
 - If you are testing out of state, YOU MUST request that the results be sent to the ALSDE (Code 7020). They will NOT be sent automatically, nor can USA forward your score copies to the ALSDE, as they will not be considered official.
- Tests are administered via two methods:
 - <u>Computer Based</u>. Computer Based tests are offered more frequently than Paper Based tests. Although some scores are made available immediately after testing via the computer based method, they are <u>NOT</u> official scores and cannot be used as such. Computer based scores are made available to reporting institutions only after the entire testing window has closed for that test period.
 - <u>Paper Based</u>. Please be aware that not all tests are offered Paper Based, nor are all offered for each paper based session. Please check individual tests for available testing dates.
