- **1.** Minutes of the September 30, 2020 meeting were approved as distributed.
- **2.** Dr. Kovaleski distributed a handout titled *"Creating a New USA Vision Statement"*. Each department was asked to develop a University vision statement through their department's lenses and explain how this statement connects to what is important in their unit/department. In turn, the college is to submit a draft University Vision Statement to the Provost no later than December 11, 2020.

If a student does not attend our college ceremony the student will still be recognized at the University Ceremony. - **4.** Scholarships Josh Wooden proposed a change to the structure of the college scholarship committee to include three subgroups of committees based on the eligibility criteria of the scholarships. The criteria will include scholarships for single departments, shared between departments, and all teacher certification programs.
- 5. Dr. Stefurak reported that faculty need to update their profiles on the website.
- **6.** Faculty Search Updates Dr. Santoli reported that the LTE Secondary Social Studies and Elementary Science Education positions have narrowed their searches down to three candidates each. The Educational Leadership Search Committee is in the process of reviewing applicant files.
