## PROGRAM INFORMATION REQUIRING GMEC APPROVAL

The Graduate Medical Education Committee has responsibility for the oversight of residency education to include, but not limited to, the following: (I.R.III and IV)

- 1. Oversight of program changes. Specifically, the GMEC is responsible for review and approval of the following, prior to submission to the ACGME by program directors:
  - a) All applications for ACGME accreditation of new programs;
  - b) Changes in resident complement;
  - c) Major changes in program structure or length of training;
  - d) Additions and deletions of participating sites;
  - e) Appointments of new program directors;
  - f) Progress reports requested by any Review Committee;
  - g) Responses to all proposed adverse actions;
  - h) Requests for exceptions of resident duty hours;
  - i) Voluntary withdrawal of program accreditation;
  - j) Requests for an appeal of an adverse action; and,
  - k) Appeal presentations to a Board of Appeal or the ACGME.
- 2. Oversight of program accreditation: Review of all ACGME program accreditation letters of notification and monitoring of action plans for correction of citations and areas of noncompliance.
- 3. Oversight of Internal Reviews: The Internal Review Committee will provide periodic updates on the status of each programs internal review, as applicable. The updates will be documented in the GMEC minutes with the final report submitted to the committee by approximately the midpoint of the accreditation cycle.
