Ask the advisor: How do I request an override?

-Email your advisor your name, Jag number, the course you are trying to register for, the CRN and a screenshot of the registration error -If it is for an upper-level course, you will need to contact the department the course falls under

For a <u>closed</u> course, you will either need to select a different course section or contact the professor of the full course. You also may have the opportunity to join a wait list

-If you are receiving any registration error, always ask your advisor first for assistance
