

APPLICATION FOR VISITING INTERNATIONAL SCHOLAR OR VISITING INTERNATIONAL STUDENT (For those wishing to enter the U.S. on a B-1/B-2, J-1, TN, or WT/WB Visa Waiver immigration status)

An approved Visiting International Scholar or Visiting International Student (not enrolled at USA) ("Visitor") at the University of South Alabama ("USA"), wishing to apply for or holding a B-1/B-2, J-1, TN, or WT/WB Visa Waiver immigration status, is eligible for certain privileges and access to certain facilities for the duration of Visitor's stay at USA. These privileges include issuance of an official USA Visitor campus identification card upon arrival that allows use of USA Libraries without charge, as well as use of gymnasium and recreational facilities upon payment of any required fees. Visitor is also eligible to apply for on-campus housing, purchase employee campus parking permits, and purchase meal plans at the established rate.

A Visiting International Scholar or Visiting International Student is <u>not</u> eligible to participate in the retirement and insurance benefits plans that are only available to regular USA employees, utilize student services such as the Student Health Service, or take USA courses for credit without payment of appropriate tuition and fees. Those Exchange Visitors on J-1 visas must maintain the U.S. Department of State insurance requirements for the **entirety** of their stay in the U.S.

Eligibility for Visiting Scholar or Visiting Student status is limited to those who (1) are <u>not</u> on the USA payroll as an employee **and** (2) are visiting USA under the sponsorship of an academic department or school for the furtherance of scholarly interests. International Visitors may include faculty members on leaves of absence from another institution of higher learning, postdoctoral fellows, or others who hold a ter nal degree in their field and are invited to visit by a USA department or school.
