- Old Business:
- Resolution for annual COLA adjustments- The president was given the resolution on Oct. 20 and has 30 days to respond. Policy for pay equity, etc. We are still in the process of revising (definitions of equity, inversion, compression).
  - Adhoc Teaching Effectiveness Committee-NTT Instructional Track Faculty Policy-Letter sent to Provost with our concerns
  - They are trying a new process so that guests can park on campus, but we are not sure what that is; we are hoping for clarification at the next ExComm meeting.
  - Process for transfer credits is going forth so students can get advised more quickly.
  - Process by which students will have access to their books by the first day of class-- Students will have to opt out every term (only electronic books). Should be a 30% cost saving on their books that they can pick up at the book store or will have shipped to their home. There continues to be non-commitment from the bookstore regarding materials being ready and not increasing cost for students.
  - If we have policies in place that require computers, funds can be provided through OneStop, but if we don't make it a requirement then they don't make it a priority to allow scholarship and financial aid to help.
  - Currently Strategic Planning Priorities (not called Strategic Plan) is going to the board in December.

    - Nontenure Track policy being revisited and researched by Charlie Guest—hopefully outcome will be that NTT faculty will not have to wait additional time (beyond the 3 years they are granted) to be considered for promotion at year 5. Currently the way the policy is written it is being misinterpreted. A memo from the Provost could clarify the policy so that it does not have to be sent back through process. Also discussion about Instructor Third Rank—wanting to make sure it doesn't get permanently tabled.
