A Graduate Assistantship is an award made on a competitive basis to degreeseeking graduate students. Selection is based on academic performance, letters of recommendation, and, in some cases, standardized test scores. Those who are awarded a graduate assistantship are assigned duties related to their program of study, so duties vary program to program. Graduate assistants usually receive a stipend as determined by their department in addition to a tuition waiver. Graduate Students interested in Graduate Assistantship positions should apply directly to their program. Please contact your department chair or graduate program director/coordinator for information on available assistantship positions.

GRADUATE **ASSISTANTSHIPS**

TYPES OF ASSISTANTS:

GRADUATE RESEARCH ASSISTANT (GRA) Primary duty will be concerned with research.

GRADUATE ASSISTANT I (GAI) Work duties are greater than 50% devoted to research and teaching activities (research and teaching activities can include assisting in grading papers, lab work, etc. or assisting a faculty member with research or time spent involved with thesis and dissertation research).

GRADUATE ASSISTANT II (GAII) Work duties are less than 50% devoted to research and teaching. Graduate Assistant II work duties may include clerical, administrative, and other appropriate duties as long as these occupy the majority of the student's work assignment.

GRADUATE TEACHING ASSISTANT (GTA) Primary responsibility for teaching appropriate classes as well as other duties in support of instruction.
