

## **Graduating Student Survey: [Summer Semester 2020]**

Office of Institutional Effectiveness

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The Graduating Student Survey was designed to gather opinions of graduating students related to various components of the educational experience at the University of South Alabama and their post-graduation plans. The Graduate Student Survey was conducted electronically using the Qualtrics survey system. It included Likert scale, multiple choice, and open-ended questions. The survey launched on [Insert Opening Date] and closed on [Insert Closing Date]. Participation was voluntary and reminder emails were sent to non-respondents every three days before the close of the survey.

### **Sample**

The sample consisted of students who graduated in Summer 2020. The final sample of graduating students consisted of **597** students; **344** participants completed the survey for a response rate of **57%**. Respondent demographics are displayed in the following tables (n = number of respondents).
