Grading

- Grading deadlines are published in the Academic Calendar (<u>https://www.southalabama.edu/aca</u> <u>demiccalendar/</u>)
- Grades are visible in PAWS (Personal Access Web System)
- Mid-term grades are posted ~ 7 weeks into the fall and spring semesters
- Final grades are posted 3-4 business days after the last day of final exams



Transfer Credit

- Transfer work must be from regionally accredited post -secondary institutions.
- An official evaluation of transfer credit will be performed once USA receives an official document. Students may view transferred credit within 5-7 business days via the unofficial transcript in PAWs.
