4. I will not ship or hand-carry the items, equipment, technology, or software listed under this exception to Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, Syria, or other <u>OFAC listed countries</u>. For travel to any of these countries, I will contact the University Office of Research Compliance and Assurance for assistance with any temporary export needs.
