

USA cybersecurity researchers in the School of Computing are investigating methods for protecting software against malicious attacks such as code injection, reverse engineering, and cloning. The research focuses on how hardware-based partitioning and polymorphic circuit variation can strengthen application security without adding significant overhead and is funded by National Science Foundation grants totaling over \$2.5 million.


For FY 2014, the University received a total of \$60,199,534 in externally sponsored awards. The *Annual Report for FY 14* is produced by the Office of Research and Economic Development and details externally-funded research activity, clinical trials, and intellectual property activity. Additionally, the *Annual Report for FY 14* also includes a report detailing research expenditures for FY 14, provided by the Division of Financial Affairs, and a record of awarded investigators which credits both principal investigators and co-investigators who receive funding.

Highlights of the *Annual Report for FY 14* include the following:

- In FY 14, a record 283 awards were received.
- The College of Arts and Sciences awards increased for the third straight year.
- Eight of the 17 reporting colleges, schools and divisions reported an increase in total funding over FY 13.
- This year's annual awards include \$19,819,247 in Pell grants and other federal student assistance programs.
- Research expenditures in FY 14 totaled \$52,802,613. The report includes two sections – Expenditures by Division and Expenditures by Source.
- Clinical trials activity as reported by the South Alabama Medical Science Foundation includes 47 awards totaling \$647,427.

Gross licensing revenues received in FY 2014 are reported by the Office of Intellectual Property Management and total \$2,570,007. The larger portion of this revenue was attributable to license agreement between the South Alabama Medical Science Foundation and a subsidiary of Merck KGaA. Other key statistics include fifteen (15) invention disclosures submitted, twelve (12) U.S. patents filed, three (3) U.S. patents issued, and one (1) license/option agreement executed.

I look forward to working with all of you to be a strong partner in the advancement of fundamental and translational research here at the University of South Alabama.



# DISTRIBUTION OF SPONSORED FUNDING


## BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2014

## BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2014



## BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2014





# DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS


## BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2014

## BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2014



## BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2014






## BY UNIVERSITY TOTAL FY 10 - FY 14

## BY ACADEMIC FY 10 - FY 14



## HEALTH SCIENCES FY 10 - FY 14


