

RE: *Annual Report for FY 2018*

For FY 2018, the University received a total of \$61,155,119 in externally sponsored awards. The *Annual Report for FY 2018* is produced by the Office of Research and Economic Development and details externally funded research activity, clinical trials activity, faculty development programs, and intellectual property activity. The Division of Finance and Administration provides a report detailing research expenditures.

Highlights of the *Annual Report for FY 2018* include the following:

- Increased number of proposal submissions: College of Engineering, the Mitchell Cancer Institute, Mitchell College of Business, University Libraries, and the University Hospitals.
- Increased amount of external funding: Colleges of Education and Professional Studies, Medicine, and Nursing, Mitchell College of Business, School of Computing, Mitchell Cancer Institute, University Hospitals, and University Libraries.
- Increased number of awards received: Colleges of Allied Health Professions, Medicine, and Nursing, Mitchell Cancer Institute, School of Computing, Mitchell College of Business, and University Hospitals.
- This year's annual awards include \$21,525,810 in federal student assistance programs.

For FY 2018, the University received a total of \$61,155,119 in externally sponsored awards. The *Annual Report for FY 2018* is produced by the Office of Research and Economic Development and details externally-funded activity, clinical trials, and intellectual property activity. Additionally, the *Annual Report for FY 2018* also includes a report detailing research expenditures for FY 2018, provided by the Division of Finance and Administration, and a detailed record of awarded investigators who received funding in this fiscal year.

Gross licensing revenues received in FY 2018 are reported by the Office of Intellectual Property Management and total \$213,331. Other key statistics include thirty-five (35) invention disclosures submitted, eighteen (18) U.S. patents filed, five (5) U.S. patents issued, and one (1) license/option agreement executed.

We very much appreciate working with our USA researchers and scholars to be strong partners in the advancement of fundamental and translational research at the University of South Alabama.



DISTRIBUTION OF SPONSORED FUNDING


BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2018

BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2018



BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2018





DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS


BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2018

BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2018



BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2018



BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2018






BY UNIVERSITY TOTAL FY 14 - FY 18




